Carpooling to and from the camp will be available. After you register, someone will contact you with information about pick-up and drop off.

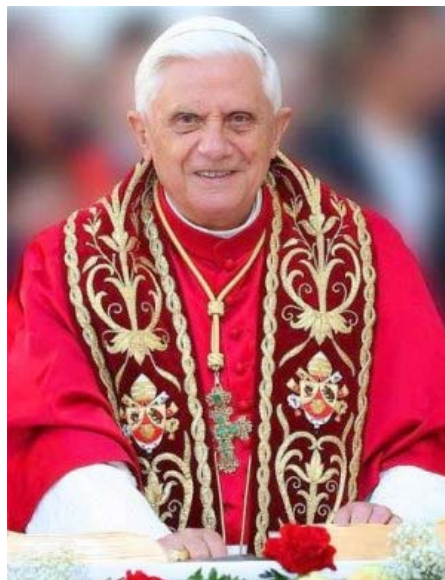
Cost: \$50 per camper. Scholarships are available. The Family rate is \$50 for the first camper, \$10 for his brother/brothers.
